



Prop 63 Innovations Grants Program

Mobile Technology Tools for Health and Wellness

Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (HCSA)-Behavioral Health Care Services (BHCS) department released a Request for Proposal (RFP) for up to \$3M for the design, development, piloting and testing of 15-20 or more mobile and desktop software applications and tools that promote health and wellness for consumers of mental health and substance-use disorder services and their family members.

HCSA-BHCS encourages qualified App Developers and Agencies that provide behavioral health services to Alameda County residents to jointly develop proposals according to the specifications in the RFP. Bidders Conferences and Networking Opportunities scheduled in September 2017. Final bids will be due November 2017.
